



ASSOCIATED MEMBERSHIP

MEDyARTE foundation will accept associated members who will be individuals with valuable skill sets and enthusiasm, whose contribution will enhance and facilitate project development. Associated members need to accept and undersign duties and obligations prior to joining as stated below.

- Associated members are persons who would like to work alongside the Trustees towards goals agreed by the trustees
- They agree and accept that all their actions will be directed towards furthering the work of the charity and not towards their own gain or purpose
- Their work will be on a voluntary basis unless agreed otherwise in writing and undersigned by the trustees once approved by the quorum
- Associated members do not have voting rights
- There is no joining or retainer fee for the Associated Members
- There is no fixed duration for which associated members must join however if they wish to relinquish their membership they should provide one month notice in writing to the Foundation's chairperson
- Should the charity trustees wish to release Associated Member from their commitment they need to provide one month notice in writing
- Associated Members can be seconded to various project as a part of a working group which would be led by one of the trustees
- Associated Members could apply to become Trustees should such a vacancy arise
- Associated members agree to do all their work to the best of their knowledge, experience and potential and avoid unnecessary wastage of resources
- Associated members commit to being trustworthy and truthful
- Associated Members may get involved in fund raising, offer their specialist skills and abilities to aid development and growth of the Foundation
- Associated Members are encouraged to put forward their own ideas
- All Associated members will be welcome to attend an Annual General Meeting
